The proposed system will also assist to identify and monitor encroachments on the acquired lands through the satellite imageries. It will help in monitoring the progress of anti-encroachments drives proactively.
- ii. Archiving and Digitization of Land Record: Electronic archiving and digitization of the record will be carried out to protect the existing land / property record and swift decision making.

NA-II <u>REVAMPING OF CDA ENFORCEMENT DIRECTORATE</u>.

DECISION:

The Board approved the following recommendations of Member Estate for revamping of Enforcement Wing.

i. Eight stations will be established at strategic locations in five Zones of the capital. Each station shall be headed by an Assistant Director having two

teams comprising 18 security guards and an inspector / sub-inspector. Keeping in view the availability of resources and the importance as well as urgency, immediately only four stations will be operationalized which shall follow with full-fledged launching of the remaining stations upon further training of staff and availability of machinery and equipment.

- ii. The essence of working of the stations shall be mobility and outreach. For this purpose following scale of vehicle / machinery shall be authorized as follows:
 - a. Vehicle for each Assistant Director 01
 - b. Patrolling vehicles 02
 - c. Beat Bikes 02
 - d. Back hoe loader 01
 - e. Dumper 01
- iii. Training in the following field shall be imparted in phases.
 - a. Anti-riots training to selected security guards under auspices of ICT police;
 - b. Training of drivers for operating heavy machinery
 - c. Basic know how abut nature of violations in coordination with various CDA directorates (i.e., Building Control, Urban Planning, Lands etc.), ICT Administration, Police, MCI and other relevant Federal Government Organizations.
- iv. The additional budget requirement for establishment of the Enforcement Stations shall be provided as per demand by the Enforcement Directorate on need basis against the relevant heads.
- v. The staffing against the posts of newly conceived post of Director Enforcement (Urban), Director Enforcement (Rural), Assistant Directors and enforcement staff etc shall be managed initially amongst the available HR. For expediency such additional posts shall be on ad-hoc basis and where regular officials in the required scales are not available, suitable junior officials may be deployed against such posts in their own pay and scale, however such arrangement shall be strictly on temporary basis and no rights shall be claimed. The HR Directorate shall create the requisite posts of Director Enforcement (Urban), Director Enforcement (Rural), Assistant Directors as soon as possible and fill up the posts in accordance with service rules i.e., by promotion and/or initial recruitment.
