2. The Chairman, CDA also attended the meeting in capacity of the Chief Commissioner, ICT, Commissioner Rawalpindi Ex-officio Member did not attend the meeting. Mr. Nayyar Ali Dada Non-Executive Member attended the meeting online. While, Mr. Naveed Ilahi, Member (Estate)/ Member (P&D), CDA Executive Members did not attend the meeting as he was on Ex-Pakistan leave.

3. In addition to the above, DG (HRD), DDG (Planning), Director UP, Director (HS), Director RP and Director MBO attended the relevant agenda item of the meeting.

4. Meeting commenced with the recitation of "Holy Quran" by Syed Safdar Ali, Secretary CDA Board. Thereafter agenda items were taken up for discussion and following decisions were made:-

#### **DECISION**

The summary was presented by the Director MBO and Member (Engineering), CDA. The board discussed the matter that annual subsidy/viability gap for all metro routes will arise due to imposition of affordable fares, keeping in view the present financial constraints of the general public. It was further discussed that before submitting the case for approval of subsidy by the Federal Government for funding the gap between actual expense and affordable fares, the matter in the first instance may be referred to the Legal Advisor, Law Wing for legal opinion for clarification as to whether this function falls under the domain of CDA. Moreover, it was further discussed that in case matter falls under the domain of CDA then for the sake of revenue generation the CDA shall explore the avenues for generation of funds so that extent of subsidy be eliminated / minimized as the project be made commercially viable. An evaluator, therefore, will be engaged in this regard without any delay.

After due deliberation and information/input of the summary, for the period till above exercise is completed, the Board principally agreed to implement the decision of the Prime Minister of Pakistan communicated vide MoI letter No. F.No.1-15/2022/CDA-III dated August 31, 2022 regarding the revision of fares to make it affordable for the general public. The below mentioned fare model for Orange, Blue, and Green Line bus services was therefore decided to be implemented with effect from 12-09-2022 in pursuance of aforementioned decision / direction of Prime Minister of Pakistan.

#### **DECISION**

The summary was presented by Member Administration, CDA. After due deliberation and on the basis of information/inputs of the summary, the board decided that matter will be referred to the concerned/relevant Departmental Promotion Committee for considering the promotion case of Mr. Mushtaq Hussain, Ex-Private Secretary (BS-18) to the post of Senior Private Secretary BS-19. #### 11.3 IMPLEMENTATION OF COURT ORDER DATED 09-10-2020 PASSED BY THE 11565/1400/BM/'22 SINGLE BENCH, NIRC IN GRIEVANCE PETITION TITLED M. SAEED DIL ETC VS 09-09-'22/11th CDA.

#### DECISION

The summary was presented by Member Administration, CDA. After due deliberation and on the basis of information/inputs of the summary, the board decided to comply the orders dated: 09-10-2020 passed by honorable NIRC Single Bench in Grievance Petition No. 4B(118) / 2020 titled Muhammad Saeed Dil etc Vs CDA, duly upheld by the full Bench NIRC vide order dated 15.12.2021 and Honorable Islamabad High Court in Writ Petition No. 351/2022 vide order dated 16.10.2022 that Mr. Saeed Dil and Kamran OGM) (BPS-05) and Mr. Rasheed Malik (OGM) (BPS-05) be upgraded as Horticulture Supervisor (BPS-11) with effect 17.01.2014 and 09.07.2013, respectively subject to final decision in CPLA No. 2780/2022 filled the Authority in Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan.

The Board further directed that aforementioned implementation shall not have any bearing on similar cases, if so any, the same shall be considered/ processed/ decided as per CDA Employees Service Regulation, 1992; however, before submission of the compliance order to honorable NIRC, the same must be vetted by Law Wing.

#### DECISION

The summary was presented by DDG Estate, CDA. After due deliberation and on the basis of information/inputs of the summary, the board preferred that the applicant may be afforded a personal hearing opportunity or representation through her counsel before the CDA Board in the forthcoming board meeting by availing online facility to present their case /point of view in this regard. The board further directed that the concerned formation may ensure to convey the directions of the board that the applicant will appear before the board personally or through her counsel or via an online facility.

#### 11.5 ASSUMING THE CONTROL OF THE SCHEME NAMELY JEDDAH TOWN 11567/1400/BM/'22 SPONSORED BY M/S GILANI HOUSING CORPORATION INTERNATIONAL (PVT.) 09-09-'22/11th LTD. AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH 22 OF SRO 64(I)/2020.

#### DECISION

The summary was presented by Director (H.S) and DDG (Planning) CDA. The board observed that summary has been brought before the Board without doing necessary ground/ home work as it lacks on following scores:

- i. The estimated development cost of the scheme has been arbitrarily worked out on old MES rates and without consulting the relevant formation of CDA.
- ii. Exact number of allottees is unknown.
- The extent of sellable area has not been properly worked out which can be iii. adjusted against the development cost, keeping in view the reported encroachments on mortgaged commercial area.
- iv. The status of the amount recovered by NAB on accounts of freezing the bank accounts of the sponsors, fate of bridge financing as promised by NAB and any transfer of recovered amount from NAB to CDA has not been ascertained.
- Status of management of the scheme and as to who is running the affairs of the v. scheme is not clear.

- vi. The extent of litigation pending or sub-judice at various forums has not been checked.
- vii. The necessary details of the scheme starting from NOC till to-date should have been made part of the summary.

After due deliberation and on the basis of information/inputs of the summary, the board showed its inability in absence of aforementioned and requisite information to give a decision. The Board therefore decided to constitute a three members committee, comprising of the officers of Engineering Wing, Planning Wing and Legal advisor of Law Wing to enquire in the matter in depth and to submit a comprehensive report to the Board, keeping in view amongst others all above stated issues. The report shall contain details starting from the NOC given to the scheme till to date while determining the officers/officials who were involved in irregularities this case. The board further authorized the Chairman, CDA for approval of the subject committee which will be notified accordingly.
