MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF C.D.A. HELD ON WEDNES.
DAY, THE 14TH OCTOBER: 1970.

Following decisions on the items mentioned in the agenda were taken.

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1. Monthly review of the progress of CDA works for September, 1970.

The Board considered the progress report in respect of the 'On-going projects'. Board made the by following observations item-wise:

# 11) Houses under Phase-II Project.

The possession of these houses should be that handed over by 21st Oct: 1970 at the latest after comple-

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# iii) Houses for Intelligence Bureau

Since the anticipatory approval for incurring the expenditure beyond 10% of the originally senctioned expenditure has been received, the execution should be expedited.

# iv) Houses for Dte. General of Pakistan Post Offices and T & T.

Since the funds have been placed at the disposal of the Director General Works by the departments, the work should be expedited.

## vi) President's House.

The delay in the execution of the project was stated to be non-settlement of fees between the CDA and the Architect for the modification to be carried out in the original design. The Chairman desired that a meeting should be arranged within two days with F.A/Member, CDA, which should also be attended to by the Legal Adviser. Legal issues should be examined and the matter settled early.

# vii) Cabinet/Foreign Office Block and National Assembly Building.

Cabinet Division should be approached to get the project approved at the earliest.

#### ix) Broadcasting House.

Funds have not yet been received as per disclosure by the D.G.W. The NIT should not be issued unless the funds are received.

#### x) National Library

Director Architecture should take immediate steps with Mr. Methew, Architect, to finalise the question of fees.

### 18. National War Memorial

The design so far prepared by the Architect be put up in the next Board meeting.

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xiv) Roads

4(i) North Service Road from Shahrah-e-Islamabad to point 76.

could not be completed because the quarters of P.P.W.D. falling in the right of way have not yet been demolished. The reasons for non-demolition are that refugees from Azad Kashmir are living in those quarters. Some times ago a commitment is stated to have been made that they will not be disturbed unless alternative accommodation is offered to them. The Board desired that following action should be taken:—

- It should be verified if the compensation has been paid to the Punjab PWD,
- 2) In case compensation has not been paid, quarters should be built out of this money for the refugees in I-10 and refugees shifted to these newly constructed quarters.
- 3) Punjab PWD should be offered quarters for quarters.

Addl: Director Lands should check up and submit the case to the Board.

In the meantime, Director Planning should inspect the spot, find out how many quarters would fall in 22' wide strip and what other enchroachments will be removed for completing the link road between Shahrah-e-Islamabad and G.T. Road. Steps should immediately be taken to complete this link road.

## xv) Water Supply

5 tubewells have been completed. The work for completion of 10 tubewells has been awarded. The work on 7 mg.reservoir is stated to be in progress.

# x) Community Buildings.

The shopping centre in Kendro in Shalimar 6 has not yet been constructed. It is high time that

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private capital should be encouraged. Proper incentives need to be given. It was explained to the Board that priliminaries have gone into with the banks. The banks are prepared to finance the private builders provided the allotment is made to them and proper guarantee for recovery of the loan is given by the prospective builders to the banks. The matter should be finalised with the banks and further action to advertise the plots for shopping centre should be taken up. CDA would construct the centre as deposit work on behalf of the private builders as the design is such that only CDA or construction companies can alone execute such a complex according to the design of the CDA.

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2. Payment of time barred compensation to Islamabad oustees.

Payment of compensation to the land-owners who have not received compensation in time.

The objection raised by Audit was considered by the Board. CDA Ordinance does not provide any limitation on the payment of such claims. Section 29. on the other hand, enjoins that CDA will make payment for acquisition of the property. Anyhow, in order to ensure the prompt payment and to know the reasons as to why the payment was not made in time, the belated claims beyond 3 years should be referred to F.A/Member who would exercise powers on behalf of the Board.

The Board expressed its concern over the delay in the finalisation of the design of the services in the Blue Area. The lay out plan so far prepared by the Architects should be put up to the Board in the next meeting.
